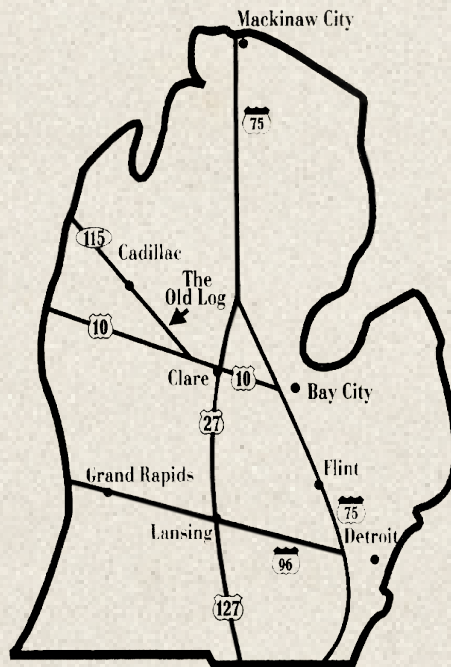

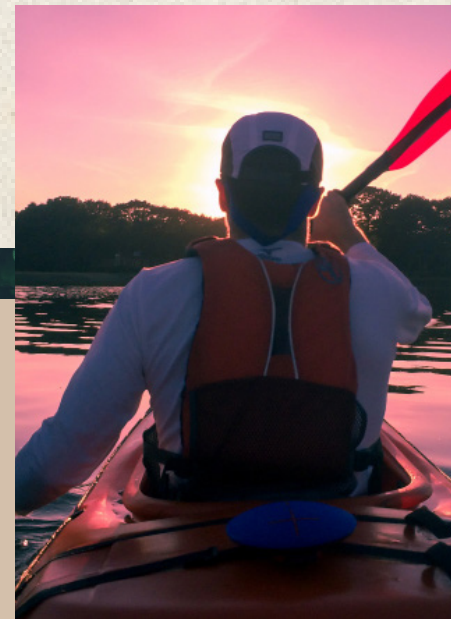


### DIRECTIONS:
